

Referring back to last week's reflection about how we bind ourselves through unforgiveness, this week's Gospel makes even more sense. Jesus said, "If anyone wants to be my follower let him deny himself and take up his cross and follow me. For whoever wants to save his life will lose it..."

What more significant way can we deny ourselves than letting go of anger and resentment and forgiving someone who has wounded us? When we hold on to our resentments, we are trying to save our lives but, in the end, we lose life. We lose peace. We lose contentment. We lose family and community. Then what will it profit us if we gain all sorts of material wealth and status if there is no joy and no rest for the soul?

Self-denial has often presented itself as not allowing ourselves pleasure or leisure. I wonder how many people throughout the ages have practiced stringent asceticism while holding major grudges against other people or whole groups of people? Way too many! In some cultures, holding onto a grudge is a matter of honor and I think most of us still hear the echoes of honor when we refuse to let go of someone else's wrongdoing. It seems so right to be offended and it feels so weak and wrong to let it go.



Jesus didn't say we would never be wounded or offended and he never said that actions taken against us would in any way be justifiable. However, he only taught forgiveness, always and everywhere, because there is no freedom otherwise. You have to let your false self go in order to gain your true self, and your true self is blessed, holy and so free from the need for respect, status, power, admiration and all those other things we continually try to grasp onto. It is when these things are withheld from us that we form resentments in order to protect ourselves from further pain.

To let go of these resentments is true denial of self.

(To anyone in an abusive situation, please remember that forgiveness does not mean consenting to being abused!)




