

There's No Escaping It

Jesus said to Nicodemus: "The one who believes in the [Son of God] is not condemned; but the one who does not believe is condemned already for not having believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God."

Wow. Stark. It sounds like pretty much the whole world, except for the little band of Jesus's followers, is condemned out of hand, because Jesus didn't say 'will be condemned'; he said, 'already condemned'.

But there's a clue about what he means in John 16. "And when he (the Holy Spirit) comes, he will prove the world to be wrong about sin and righteousness and judgement: about sin because people do not believe in me; about righteousness because I am going to the Father, where you can see me no longer; and about judgement because the prince of this world now stands condemned. (John 16:8-11)

Jesus was actually saying to Nicodemus that the one who does not believe in Christ's salvation and is condemned already is the prince of this world or Satan. God didn't send his Son to condemn the world but to save it and the coming of the Holy Spirit brought us a new understanding of sin and righteousness, an understanding that is totally different from the prevalent

Jewish understanding at the time of what was sinful, how to attain righteousness and what judgement really means. Judgement does not mean condemnation. Judgement means assessment and the Trinity's whole desire is to assess our situations and resolve them. The Trinity brings restorative justice, not retributory justice. The idea of retributory justice did not come from God; it was a lie spread by Satan to distort the true nature of God.

The true understanding of the Trinitarian law of love, forgiveness and restoration is the whole reason the Father sent the Son and the Son, in turn, sent the Holy Spirit. We are not condemned!

We can't escape the love of God.


Handcrafted Holy Land Wood Carvings June 24 & 25
