before the word Aramaic word for landowner, Matthew wrote 'anthropos', a word that means the landowner was human not divine in this parable. So, the landowner does not represent God. When Jesus asked the chief priests and elders what the landowner should do after his son has been murdered, they reply that the landowner should 'put the wretches to a miserable death'. This was what their idea of justice was and we all would tend to agree.

We can easily equate the slaves the landowner sent to the prophets God sent to the Israelites. They were pretty proficient at killing their prophets. And we can equate the son to Jesus sent by God to the vineyard of Israel and the tenants did indeed put the son to death. But the priests' and elders' judgement as to how the tenants should be treated is not the end of the story.

Could you imagine the tenants' shock and confusion if the landowner brought his son back to life, forgave the tenants for their murderous crimes and offered to allow them to tend the vineyard alongside his son?

"Unfair!" we cry. "That is so not justice! That's not what should happen to those tenants!" Yet that's what God did, along with his son. Our perceptions of justice are often pretty far off the mark when it comes to God's idea of justice. "My thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are my ways your ways," declares the Lord. "As the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways and my thoughts than your thoughts."

The next time you think you know what justice is, please remember this passage and think again.




