

When Peter and John ran to the tomb after Mary Magdalen told them that Jesus' body had been taken away, they went inside the tomb and saw all the linen wrappings lying there. However, it may not have struck you that scripture says the cloth that had been on Jesus' head was neatly rolled up and was not lying with the rest of the wrappings. When he rose from the dead, did he start to be tidy by rolling the cloth napkin neatly and then take a look at all the bandages that had been wrapped around him and say, "Ugh! No way I'm folding all that stuff!" No, Jesus wasn't being lazy. Jesus was leaving a message.

In the time of Christ, slaves and servants would set the table for their master, lay the food out and then stand somewhere where they were hidden from the master's sight but ready to do his bidding if necessary. If the master got up from the table, wadded up his napkin, tossed it untidily on the table and left the room, the servants would know the master was finished with the meal and they were free to clear up.

But if the master got up, neatly folded his napkin and placed it by his plate before leaving the room, the neatly folded napkin was saying,

"I am coming back."

"This is the day the Lord has made; let us rejoice and be glad!"


