

#### THIS WEEK IN THE PARISH

#### A few words from our Pastor:-

This past Tuesday we celebrated the Canadian Martyrs. They were eight French Jesuits who gave their lives in the 1640s to bring the Gospel to the Huron, Algonquin, and Mohawk nations. St Jean de Brebeuf, who had a special talent for languages, translated the Christian story for the Huron peoples.

On Thursday, the Church also celebrated the Lorenzo Ruiz who was a Filipino missionary who gave his life for the people of Japan in Nagasaki in the 1630s.

Mission work today is also difficult, but for different reasons. We cannot simply appeal to our own ethnicity nor to those people with whom we share a certain affinity. By our words and our lives, we are called to make Christ visible to our neighbor. However, I have found that the greatest way to make Christ visible is not by signaling our virtues. When the virtuous fall, they usually lead others into scandal anyways. Rather, let us show the world the power of forgiveness: the power to forgive others and the power to forgive ourselves. More than anything, the surpassing power of mercy reveals God's power in our lives. God bless
