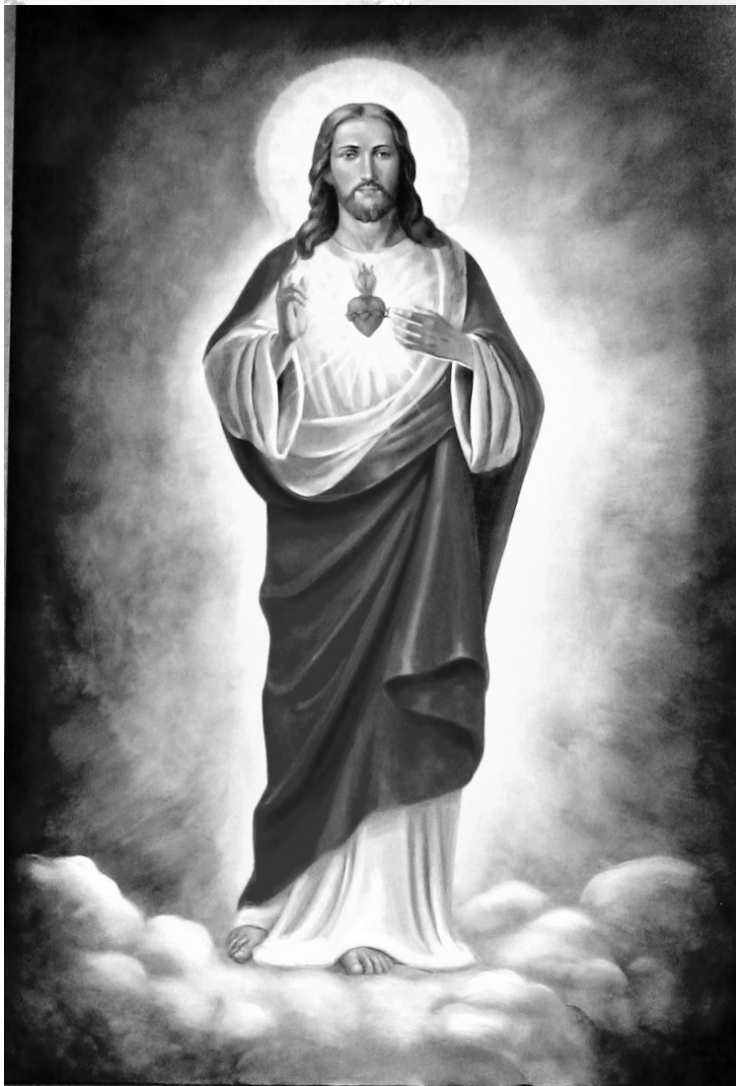

There will be a special Mass on Monday, Nov 2 at 7:00pm in celebration of All Souls Day.

On this holy day, the universal church prays for the dead whose faith God alone knows.

All are welcome, and you are especially encouraged to attend, if you have recently lost a family member or a close friend.

First Friday All Day Adoration

Diocesan Mass for Year of Mercy

Bishop Gary Gordon invites you to a special Mass at the Cathedral on Tues, Dec 8 (Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception) at 7:00pm to mark the beginning of the Year of Mercy and the 50th Anniversary of the conclusion of Vatican II. A reception will follow.

Special Mass Sat, Dec 5 at 9:30am

To coincide with the arrival of their new Altar Missal, the Ordinariate Community –Fellowship of Blessed John Henry Newman—*worshipping at St. Columba Church*—will celebrate a Solemn Sung Mass at the Cathedral to introduce the Ordinariate Liturgy to the Diocese of Victoria on a wider scale. This is a valid Catholic liturgy

and will replace the usual Mass that morning.

Refugee Family Project

How will the St. Andrew's Refugee Committee bring in a refugee family?

A memorandum of understanding has been drafted between the Anglican Diocese and the Roman Catholic Diocese. The agreement states that St Andrew's Cathedral assumes the financial liability while using the administrative connection between the Anglican Diocese (the Sponsorship Agreement Holder) and the UNHCR (the UN refugee body). The UNHCR certifies a family as having "refugee status" and then the Anglican Diocese, speaking on our behalf, calls the family to come to Canada.
