Last week I wrote about committing acts of love and kindness to encounter Jesus in our daily lives. I could easily write the exact same words as last week for this week's Gospel about preparing the way of the Lord.

Preparing the way of the Lord includes 'metanoia' or the act of turning around and turning away from negative actions, mindsets, God-views and world views but preparing the way of the Lord is much more than that. As I implied last week, every act of love and kindness prepares the way for Christ to come. When we give without expectation of payment, the path of Christ becomes a little straighter and a little less hilly for the one who receives our love. Every kindness, no matter how small, can fill up a pothole that has caused someone to stumble on their way to the Lord. Perhaps the ones we respond to gently and kindly will not immediately have a personal encounter with Christ but the road has been smoothed and preparations made. The next person who offers love may indeed be received as an ambassador of Jesus. We don't know and it's none of our business. Our business is to love and to continually prepare the way of the Lord.

The way of the Lord is a not a road filled with criticism, condemnation or judgement. It's not a way strewn with sharp caustic words or 'righteous'

resentments. We can't fill in valleys with anger, contempt or entitlement. Those things are actually looming and threatening mountains that block the way to the Lord for anyone who may consider seeking him. The Way of the Lord, the Highway of our God, is a two-way street. It is a path for the Lord to come to us and it is a path that encourages us and others to run to greet the Lord on his way.

Love repairs and prepares the way. The Way of the Lord is not just a metaphorical path; it is also the way Jesus acted and acts:

With love and kindness.
