Matthew: The King and His Kingdom

This fall and winter, Sacred Heart Parish will be hosting Step 2 - following the Bible Timeline.

Matthew: The King and His Kingdom is an exciting study that explores the life and mission of Jesus as recorded in the Gospel.

Matthew demonstrates how the promises and prophecies of the Old Testament are fulfilled in Christ, who establishes a New Law and inaugurates the Kingdom of Heaven on earth.

Participants will see Jesus as the awaited Messiah who relives the life and struggles of Israel to become the faithful and victorious King.
