Listen Carefully

Jesus said, "My sheep hear my voice. I know them and they follow me." In Jesus's day several shepherds would herd their sheep at night into the same fenced area for safety and let them all mingle together. In the morning a shepherd would start calling his sheep and his flock would follow him because they knew his voice.

Do you know the voice of your Shepherd? There's no space here for a detailed description of what Jesus's voice sounds like but I can tell you a couple of ways you can tell when it's not his voice.

Jesus's voice does not condemn; it convicts. Conviction is a realization that something is wrong with what you are thinking or doing and you feel inspired to do something about it. It is not a sense of heavy guilt and shame; it is a sense that God's love is calling you to think and act differently and that he will give you the grace to change. It's freedom, not a jail sentence.

Jesus's voice does not push you and guilt trip you, telling you that if you don't do a certain action immediately, everything will fall apart and it will be all your fault. In Jesus's day, the Shepherd led the sheep but the butcher drove the sheep. Jesus's voice invites. He invites you to follow and participate in what he's doing and he delights in your participation. He doesn't use pressure tactics. If something is making you feel harried and driven to do something, it's not Jesus. It's the butcher.

Jesus doesn't actually need you for anything. He simply wants you to be the you he created you to be and he uses certain situations to form and transform you. A true shepherd doesn't need his sheep for anything but, still, he watches over them, takes care of their needs and leads them to the best grass and the stillest waters. No one can snatch you away!

The Father has given you to Jesus and to Jesus you are greater than all else.



ST. MATTHIAS the Apostle May 14

Patron of Alcoholics; carpenters; tailors; smallpox; hope; perseverance; Great Falls-Billings, Montana; Trier.

Tradition has it that St. Matthias died in Colchis, Armenia. He was in the New Testament, among the 12 Apostles as the disciple who, according to the Acts of the Apostles (1:21–26) was chosen to replace Judas Iscariot after Judas betrayed Jesus.



Jesus' choice of 12 Apostles points to a consciousness of a symbolic mission. There were 12 tribes of Israel; that the community maintained after the Crucifixion. The Acts reveals that Matthias accompanied Jesus and the Apostles from the time of the baptism of Jesus to the Ascension and that, when it came time to replace Judas, the Apostles cast lots between Matthias and another candidate, St. Joseph Barsabbas. St. Jerome and the early Christian writers St. Clement of Alexandria and Eusebius of Caesarea attest that Matthias was among the 72 disciples paired off and dispatched by Jesus. Soon after his election, Matthias received the Holy Spirit with the other Apostles (Acts 2:1–4). He is not mentioned again in the New Testament.

It is generally believed that Matthias ministered in Judaea and then carried out missions to foreign places. Greek tradition states that he Christianized Cappadocia, a mountainous district now in central Turkey, and later journeyed to the region about the Caspian Sea, where he was martyred by crucifixion and, according to other legends, chopped apart. His symbol, related to his alleged martyrdom, is either a cross or a halberd. St. Helena, mother of the Roman emperor Constantine the Great, reputedly transported Matthias's relics from Jerusalem to Rome


