Installation as Acolytes

Next Saturday, Feb. 17th, Bishop Gary will celebrate our 5pm Mass and during the Mass install four candidates for the Permanent Diaconate as Acolytes. This is a necessary and final step on their journey to Ordination, which will take place in July. While the duties of the Acolyte are minimal, the brief ritual emphasizes that these men are destined for service at the Altar (in addition to their ministry of Charity) and that they should learn all matters concerning public divine worship and strive to grasp their inner spiritual meaning so as to offer themselves daily to God and be an example to all as well as having

a sincere love for the Mystical Body of Christ, the people of God, especially the weak and sick.
