Extra-Ordinary Form of the Mass

On Sat, June 24 at 11am St Andrew’s Cathedral will host an Extra-Ordinary Form of the Mass celebration for the Solemnity of St. John the Baptist. Extra-ordinary refers to the fact that it will be the Mass Ritual as mandated in 1962 and not the Ordinary Mass,

which is what we normally celebrate in our parish Churches. The Sung Mass will be in Latin and celebrated by Fr. Pablo Santa Maria Watson from Vancouver. This celebration of the Extra-Ordinary Form of the Mass is done in the context of the Cathedral’s 125th anniversary celebrations. A collection will be taken to assist with expenses.
