

Thanks to a workshop in journalism offered by our partner the Association of Independent Journalists, this courageous young woman started to use her blog to write about the discrimination faced by women with disabilities and to encourage these women to believe in their potential. AJI has offered media workshops to 170 women and now they can make their voices heard!


