When Jesus presses the disciples with the question, "Who do you say that I am?", Peter replies that Jesus is the Messiah, the long-expected Saviour, the Anointed One. When Jesus foretells His death and resurrection, He rebukes a well-intentioned and loving Peter by saying, "Get behind me, Satan!" What did Peter and the disciples need to understand?

In a painful way, they needed to know what kind of Messiah Jesus was going to be. He was not going to be a powerful, earthly king. Instead, the Son of Man would be the Suffering Servant for the world. He would undergo great suffering, rejection and death, and after three days rise through the power of the resurrection. The disciples needed to set their minds on God's merciful and loving ways of seeing and doing things. Not an easy task; but their actions would be the living mark of their faith in serving others.

When we understand Jesus' true identity, we are invited to enter more intimately into a loving relationship with God. We are encouraged by the Holy Spirit to follow Jesus in greater faith and trust, to experience the mercy and love of God in our hearts, and to find meaning and purpose in our service to a broken world.

Lord help us to know and follow You, now and always.

Pastoral Care Outreach Training

Register by Thursday, September 16 for online Pastoral Care Outreach Training

The Pastoral Care Outreach Training series will again be offered online this fall. Nine free sessions will be held via Zoom on Saturday mornings from 9:30 – noon, starting on September 25 and running until November 27, 2021 (with a break on October 9 for Thanksgiving). Participants who attend all sessions will receive a Certificate of Completion.

Consider these questions: How can I encourage people to talk and share their stories? Can I really have an effect on someone's health with my visit? What is meant by the Ministry of Presence? Whether you are a



member of your parish Pastoral Care Team or an Extraordinary Minister of Communion, a member of the Knights of Columbus, CWL or St. Vincent de Paul, a caregiver to a family member, or someone who is considering adding these skills and would like to get involved, this training program is important. It will show why those who visit the sick are unique, and how they can offer more than a friendly visit — they can be the hands and face of Christ to others. Until pastoral access to homes, hospitals, nursing homes, and health care facilities is fully available, Bishop Gary Gordon feels "it is important to have parishioners trained at the ready to provide a caring and compassionate experience to those who are most in need."


