The Sermon on the Mount by Carl Heinrich Bloch

"Rejoice in that day and leap for joy, for surely your reward is great in heaven;..."

(Luke 6.23)

In Luke's Gospel, Jesus repeatedly overturns our comforting expectations. This Sunday, Jesus tells us that the poor, the hungry and those who weep are blessed, but woe to those who are rich, well-fed and laughing. "Woe to you when all speak well of you." Jesus is not laying down moral principles here; He is speaking directly to me.

This is not what I want to hear on a cold Sunday in February. The winter has been long, and I am anxious for spring to arrive. I am glad to have a warm home, good food and good company, but I still want more. I always want more of the good things of life. But Jesus says, "You have received your consolation."

In two and a half weeks, Lent will begin. My goal for this season should be to go deeper than prayer, fasting and almsgiving. While essential, those are externals. Rather, such practices should help me grow more deeply into Christ.

My solidarity with Jesus includes a solidarity with the poor, the hungering and the sorrowful. Solidarity means more than a feeling of unity in my heart; it means that I, in some way, experience what the marginal ones are experiencing. Ascetic practices can nurture that experience. Better still is to have an encounter with those who suffer. Through this encounter, February will become spring.




