The Unveiling By Jean Allen

Since Jesus spoke the words about what will happen before he returns, there probably hasn't been a time in history when people could not look around at world events and say, "The time must be near. Look how bad it is!" Wars, persecution, famines, earth quakes, other natural disasters, plagues...even today we can read the news and think, "The apocalypse must be near!"

The word 'apocalypse' does not mean a time of unprecedented disaster and violence. It means 'unveiling'. So, what is unveiled? If disasters, plagues and wars have always been with us, perhaps the apocalypse has been happening since Jesus's death and resurrection and what has been being unveiled all along is the self-justified violence of humans towards one another and the earth. We cannot deny that over the centuries, it has become more and more evident how human violence is a way of life.

But at the same time, what is also being unveiled is God's prodigious love and mercy. It's becoming harder and harder to commit so called 'sacred violence' in the name of God. We are all violent but God's goodness just keeps blossoming as we, the Church and the world, find ourselves stripped of any justification for keeping anyone downtrodden or excluded.

God's mercy is being unveiled and, as the book of Wisdom said a couple of weeks ago, God overlooks people's sins so that they may repent.

You may be thinking, "Well, I'm not violent!" Think again. Do you ever lose your temper and feel justified in doing so? Are you completely free of all resentment and anger in regards to anything, be it your spouse, the government, a neighbour or a group? Inner resentment and anger are the seeds of all violence and Jesus said that if you have called someone a fool, you might as well have committed murder.

We need to be fully open to the apocalypse, the unveiling, of our own hearts and we need to be far more aware of the apocalytic unveiling of God's relentless mercy.

We need to be apocalypticized!

We remember

who gave their lives in service,
and their families & friends
who continue to pray
and honour them.



SEEKING TRUTH, RECONCILIATION AND HEALING

Diocesan Faith Day ~ Saturday, November 26, 2022

Presenter: Archbishop Donald Bolen



Pope Francis appointed Bishop Bolen as the eighth Archbishop of Regina, formerly the Bishop of Saskatoon, on Monday, July 11, 2016.

Archbishop Bolen was born in Gravelbourg, Saskatchewan. He obtained his Baccalaureate degree with Honours in Religious Studies with a minor in English from Campion College at the University of Regina. Later, he entered the Seminary of Saint Paul in Ottawa, and completed his theological studies at Saint Paul University in Ottawa, obtaining a Bachelors, Masters and Licentiate in Theology.

He was ordained a priest on October 12, 1991 for the Archdiocese of Regina. After ordination and a couple of years of pastoral

ministry, he began a Doctorate of Philosophy at the University of Oxford in England, working on the reception of the documents of the Anglican-Roman Catholic International Commission (ARCIC), with Fr. Edward Yarnold SJ as doctoral supervisor. Prior to completion of his doctorate, he was asked to return to Regina to teach at Campion College, where he taught in the Department of Religious Studies, teaching courses in World Religions, Christology, Contemporary Christianity, Ecumenism, and Methodology of Religious Studies.

Archbishop Bolen is currently a Member of the Pontifical Council for the Promotion of Christian Unity, Co-Chair of the International Anglican-Roman Catholic Commission for Unity and Mission, and Co-Chair of the Canadian Anglican-Roman Catholic Theological Dialogue; and is the Co-Chair of the Justice and Peace Commission of the Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops. He served as the Co-Chair of the Joint International Commission for Dialogue between the World Methodist Council and the Catholic Church (2013-16) and as a member of the International Consultation between the Catholic Church and the World Evangelical Alliance (2009-2016). He has written and lectured extensively in the field of ecumenism.

For years, Archbishop Bolen has been instrumental with both the Vatican and Indigenous communities to make Pope Francis's recent visit to Canada a reality.
