THIS WEEK IN THE PARISH

A few words from our Pastor:-

Here we are at Holy Week! This next week is the summit of the Christian year just as the Cross and Resurrection of Jesus is the summit of all creation. It is hard to imagine how a single moment in Israel changed and redeemed the Universe forever, but that is exactly what we believe as Christians. This is why, in accord with the Scriptures, Jesus gave us the Sacraments to participate in those sacred days. Without the Sacraments, our faith would be a mere mental exercise. Time and space would disconnect us from the Saviour we confess as Lord. When we celebrate the Sacraments, we are in the story. We are Pilate when we prefer politics to Truth. We are Caiaphas when we prefer the nation and its traditions to the Creator. We are Judas when we betray Jesus with a kiss. We are Peter when we deny Jesus, repent, and subsequently accept his forgiveness. We are Mary Magdalene when we weep at the Cross, but unexpectedly find Jesus in the garden. We are the Church when we proclaim that Jesus is Risen. We share in his triumph when we declare that he has conquered sin and death and revealed the face of God.

Do make an effort to participate in all of our Holy Week celebrations or as many as possible. Pray for those preparing for Baptism this Easter. Remember that your own Baptism and the Eucharist that we celebrate is the greatest gift in the world as it feeds us for a journey beyond this world.
