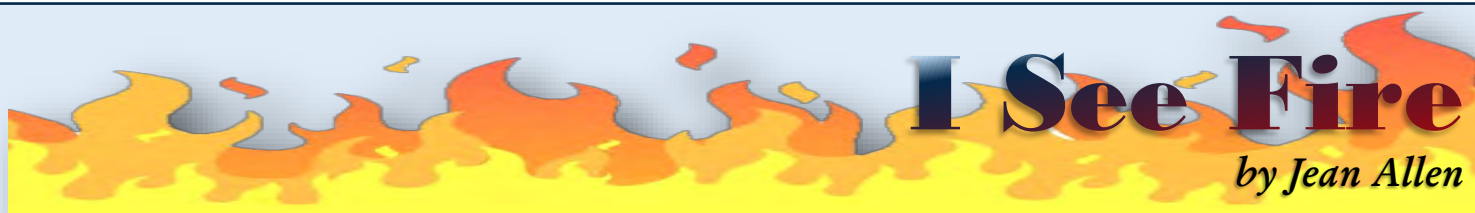

Bear with me here while I set up some background. Throughout Israel's history, right up to Jesus's death and resurrection, the nation's whole social fabric was based on law, taboos, and sacrifice. These are what kept the peace and kept things somewhat stable. Everyone knew their place; everyone knew the law, and sacrifice was the oil that kept the machinery operating.

When Jesus spoke of bringing fire to the earth, saying that he didn't come to bring peace but rather division and how households would be divided against each other, he wasn't saying that those things were his will. He was saying it would be a natural progression after he destroyed the power of sacrifice. Within 70 years after his death, there was no more sacrifice in the Temple in Jerusalem, and there hasn't been to this day. Has this brought peace upon the world? We know it hasn't.

The kind of peace sacrifice brought Israel was a fragile peace based on a misunderstanding of what God wanted. He kept saying through his prophets that he wanted mercy, not sacrifice. Christ did away with sacrifice but we have yet to fully comprehend what mercy means. Our lack of comprehension is what has divided nations and households, and brought fire to the earth. We have a very limited understanding of how critical mercy and forgiveness is to our world, our nations, and our families.

The way Jesus died on the cross – completely and utterly forgiving everyone who tortured him, jeered at him, and betrayed him – is what he desires of us. But we haven't been so great at listening, and taking it to heart. As soon as someone wounds us, whether it's the government, a neighbour, or a family member, we jump on the wagon of "I've got every right to be angry, and hurt," and fiery division ensues.

Forgiveness and mercy aren't just nice theories. They aren't just graces we can receive from God. They are the cooling waters for the fire and the oil of healing for the divisions. They are our choices.

Meanwhile, Jesus waits.
