

Message from Bishop Gary Gordon

“Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,
Our prayers are with all those affected by Hurricane Matthew in Haiti, and your parish will be receiving donations to aid those who have been effected.

All funds will be directed to Development and Peace which is working with Caritas Internationalis to respond to this emergency. You may donate directly to Development and Peace Caritas Canada at: <http://www.devp.org> or you may donate via the parish; simply indicate that it is for **Haiti**.

Together, let us continue to pray for those who are so much in need of our aid.”

Development and Peace / Caritas Canada

\$50,000 has just been sent to Caritas Haiti for immediate humanitarian assistance following Hurricane Matthew.

D&P’s intervention with the Caritas network will enable it to take charge of supporting 2,700 of the families victimized by the hurricane with food distribution, and will reduce the risk of spreading basic infectious diseases (diarrhea, cholera, malaria, etc.) for those 2,700 families.

As well, D&P is launching an emergency campaign for Haiti across Canada. Funds raised will be used to meet needs in health, water, and to provide shelter, food and non-food items in the most affected regions.

We encourage the entire Catholic community to support those affected by this disaster through prayer and support to the emergency relief.
