# THIS WEEK IN THE PARISH

## A few words from our Pastor:-

First, I would like to thank everyone for a very successful event on December 7th.

We received \$1,154 in donations to the Soup Kitchen that we matched from the red basket account to Anawim house. Additionally, William (the chef) generously donated his honourarium of \$1,500 to various needs in Africa. Additionally, a \$300 donation was made to the CCO ministries at UVic in thanksgiving to Chantal and Jeremy for providing the music for the Mass.

This does not undercut those who helped set up, clean up, and provided other foods. All in all, it was a great night! Continuing our Parish governance series, now is the time to turn to the Parish Administrative Assistant (PAA)otherwise known as Katherene. The PAA is a practical necessity in most Parishes and especially in our own.

The pastor is the administrator of the Parish, but he cannot do it on his own. As the pastor's responsibilities are universal within the Parish community, the scope of the PAA also tend to be universal as well. Katherene does have an articulated job description, but it also has a clause adding: "To perform any and other duties as assigned." That sort of vagueness aside, she does have certain concrete duties: Compile and record collections, issue communications to the various ministries and Parish communities, keep records of Parish financial transactions, manage the Parish property, keep records of Sacraments celebrated, answer phone calls and emails sent to the Parish, coordinate and set-up funerals, and put up with the pastor. This does not even take into account the various ministries that are not in her official job description.

To put it bluntly, this is a remarkably complex job and we are very blessed to have Katherene in the position.

That being said, she isn't a sister or a priest. She has a life outside the Parish office. Furthermore, a competent PAA can lead the Parish into the danger of thinking: "Katherene can do it." Each of us are called to take responsibility for our Parish community.

That is why, one of my favourite things to say to Katherene at the end of the day is: "Go home!"




