

#### THIS WEEK IN THE PARISH

#### A few words from our Pastor:-

Over the last few weeks, I have offered some tools to aid in our growth as disciples. There are prayer tools like the rosary and apps like Ibreviary. Ministry is also a means of deepening our discipleship as day to day contact with the Church is meant to cure us of unrealistic spiritual fantasies. It is hard to believe that life is simple when you have card for the dying. Most importantly, the regular reading of the Word of God is essential -especially in the contemporary world. In my life, I have found that the regular reflection on the Word of God is the best means of growing in wisdom.

However, in addition to these tools, another great tool is humility. Humility does not mean thinking ourselves debased. It means truthfully acknowledging who we are. That means acknowledging our talents without over estimating their meaning. It also means the acceptance of the fact that we did not create ourselves and remain accountable to God.

However, humility also means accepting our limitations. When we read the Scriptures or the writings of the Saints, we can often be confused or feel that we simply do not understand. That is fine. We don't understand completely. It is pride or hubris that thinks that we can completely understand God's Word. The religious zealot, certain of his or her own truth, is not the humble disciple. He is often the proud man to whom Jesus cries out: Get behind me!

In my theology courses, I have often thought that a passing grade should be %5 and that an A+ should be %25. How could it be any different if God is our goal?
