"... for the Son of Man came not to be served but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many."

(Mark 10.45)

Jesus overturns the standard conception of power as something that comes at the expense of the ruled. He also explodes the disciples' related assumption that their proximity to Him bears certain special privileges that set them above others. The climax of this weekend's Gospel is forceful: Jesus came to serve and not to be served. True leadership is servant leadership and those who are greatest in the kingdom must become like slaves, willing to suffer and even die, for the common good. The glory of the kingdom comes not through violent means, but rather in and through the Cross.

Like the disciples, we are not immune to distorted conceptions of power and leadership. Living in the kingdom demands that we challenge our tendencies to side with those in power against the weak. The world will know us as true disciples of Jesus when we commit ourselves in loving service to the common good.


In October Rosary


