Lighting the Advent Candles The Third Sunday of Advent: Joy (Rose)


The Third Sunday of Advent is the Sunday of Joy. Our joy is in God and in His Son Jesus Christ. Like peace, joy is a gift from God. It overtakes us and fills us when we remember what God has done and what He has promised to do.

We light a candle on this day to remind us that Christ came, and is coming, so that all people might have a rich and abundant life. We thank God for the hope He gives us and for the peace He bestows, and for joy He pours into our hearts.









"Who are you?" the priests and Levites asked John. "Who are you and what is your reason for being? Are you this, are you that? How can we trip you up and get you to claim something preposterous? How can we diminish your importance to the people and let them see what a fraud you are?"

But, you know what? John gave them nothing to grab onto because he desired no claim to fame. He didn't have grandiose ideas about who he was or who he wanted to be. He was just a voice in the wilderness, no one terribly important; the important one was coming soon but he was not the one. However, this didn't mean that John had no sense of himself; he was in no way needy of approval from anyone because he knew exactly who he was. He didn't need to prove himself to anybody or make himself seem important because he had already found his identity in God.

Who are you? What is your reason for being? Do you need approval or admiration? If you don't get approval and admiration, does it make you resentful or make you feel diminished somehow? Are you content to play second fiddle because what you do is not what creates your whole identity? If you suddenly found yourself incapacitated and unable to do what you have always done, would that completely erode your sense of worth and value? How much do you do simply in order to justify your existence?

The need to find our worth reflected in the eyes of those around us is deeply human but that's not where we will find it. That need puts limitations on who we are and who we can be. Thanks be to God that John and Jesus had discovered where their value and worth resided. It was not in the eyes of people but in the eyes of God. They did not find their identities in how much they were loved by people.


