**A few words from our Pastor:-**

A few months ago, someone hiding in the cover of the internet, parodied my email account and asked people for money. In the last few days, they have renewed their evil behaviours. We long to live in a world where such pathetic behaviours do not occur, but since it is clear that we do not, it is incumbent on us to do what we can to minimize the impact of evil in the world and to reward those that do good. Our culture has developed a dangerous habit of over-critiquing those who are attempting to do good while giving those who do evil a pass. Not only does this embolden evil, but it discourages us from doing good.

Because evil hides in the shadows or even under a mask of virtue, our Diocese and Parishes are beginning a training program to help our priests, staff, and volunteers recognize the warning signs of abusive behaviour in our churches. Neil Lundin, our Parish’s Responsible Ministry coordinator, will be helping us implement this and other strategies to make our Parish safer. Evil feeds on willful naive and fear. It is our Christian responsibility to bring light to those places just as we let the light of Christ examine the thoughts and motives of our hearts.
