Christ is risen! Alleluia!

**Easter Message from** 

Fr. Konrad Zaborowski, S.D.S.

The Resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ is most fundamental to our

identity as Christians. We cannot find

any sense in the practice of our faith if

Christ is not risen! Easter Sunday is

the most important, and the most



crucial celebration of the whole year! And the celebration of the Lord's Resurrection was the very first liturgy celebrated by the first church.

If Christ had not been raised, then empty is our preaching. Empty, too, would be your faith. Then we would also be false witnesses to God, because we testified against God that He raised Christ, whom He did not raise, if in fact the dead are not raised (1 Cor 15:14-15).

What happened the moment Jesus Christ was raised?

In the Gospel of St. John, we find the very first encounter of the Risen Lord with Mary of Magdala, and what He said to her:

The Appearance to Mary of Magdala.

But Mary stayed outside the tomb weeping. And as she wept, she bent over into the tomb and saw two angels in white sitting there, one at the head and one at the feet where the body of Jesus had been.

And they said to her, "Woman, why are you weeping?" She said to them, "They have taken my Lord, and I don't know where they laid him."

When she had said this, she turned around and saw Jesus there, but did not know it was Jesus.

Jesus said to her, "Woman, why are you weeping? Whom are you looking for?" She thought it was the gardener and said to him, "Sir, if you carried him away, tell me where you laid him, and I will take him."

Jesus said to her, "Mary!" She turned and said to him in Hebrew, "Rabbouni," which means Teacher.

Jesus said to her, "Stop holding on to me, for I have not yet ascended to the Father. But go to my brothers and tell them, 'I am going to my Father and your Father, to my God and your God."

Mary of Magdala went and announced to the disciples, "I have seen the Lord," and what he told her.

It is fascinating how delicate and sensitive Jesus is towards our human condition. His very first words immediately after His Resurrection were about Mary's sufferance. Why are you weeping? Why are you in pain? The Lord is always close to everyone's suffering. The most amazing miracle of the Empty Tomb has this purpose: to break the bond of death, and sin, and sufferance. After hearing her confession, He re-establishes their personal connection and calls her by her name. Our Lord knows how to deal with our weaknesses and sufferance, and He desires to have an individual personal relationship with each one of His followers. She recognizes Him. At that moment, she knows and understands. He doesn't wait. Immediately, He sends her on the mission, making Mary of Magdala the very first missionary to proclaim the Good News of His Resurrection.
