## Right Places And Better Parts

Are you a Mary or a Martha? I think the main tendency is to secretly decide that we are Martha, always worried and distracted by many things.

The truth is, we are both. There is a Mary and a Martha in each one of us – men included. In all of us there is the ego self, needing to have situations under control and tasks prioritized and dealt with efficiently. This is our Martha who has invited the Lord into her home and wants to show him great hospitality. But while she is making sure everything is going according to her plan, she forgets to actually pay attention to Jesus or to ask him what he wants.

Then there is the part of us, our true self, that yearns for the healing and inspiring Word of the Lord. We long to have the opportunity to sit at Jesus's feet and feel his eyes upon us. We want to listen and learn and laugh and breathe a sigh of relief at what we hear. This is our Mary who, having invited the Lord into her home, wants only to be with him.

Because Jesus told Martha that Mary had chosen the better part, we feel like it's not such a great thing to be a Martha. Maybe we should be sitting in our prayer room all day at the feet of the Lord. But this would not be entirely the best thing either. We can't shut ourselves off from the world and the needs of those around us.

The clue as to why Jesus told Martha that Mary had chosen the better part was not really the outward activities of either woman; it was the inner attitudes. Martha felt overburdened and resentful. Mary was at peace in her Lord's presence. Martha could have been busy but still attentive, listening and just content to serve the Lord. Resentment causes stress which causes worry and distraction.

Mary's focus was on Jesus. Martha's focus was on herself. And that's how we tell if we have chosen the better part:

The absence of self-righteous resentment.

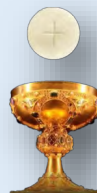

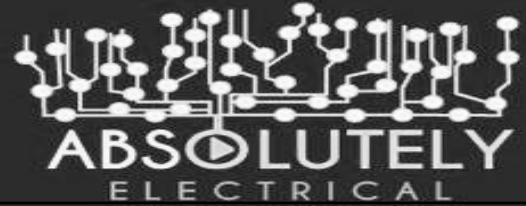
