



Not Only This But Also That

Remember the definition of 'Judgement'? To assess and resolve? In today's Gospel and in last week's Gospel about Thomas – indeed in any of the stories of Christ's post resurrection appearances – we get perfect examples of Jesus bringing judgement on his followers. What's that you say? But he treats his followers lovingly and kindly and doesn't slam them with their failures of betrayal and doubt?

Exactly!

Of course, it takes Jesus no time at all to assess people and, before he even appeared to his followers, he already knew the hearts, hurts and hopes of those he appeared to. He knew their fears. He knew their despair. Where we have a tendency to judge the doubt of Jesus' followers as weakness and failure and then leave the story at that, Jesus saw opportunities for more than superficial healing. He saw ways to not only resolve the doubts and despair but also to reveal new realities. Christ's judgement brings not only solutions to problems at hand but also opens gateways to deeper and higher revelation.

He has not changed. His judgement has not changed. The judgement Jesus brought on his followers post resurrection is exactly the same today. He knows your heart. He knows your fears, doubts and despair but if you allow him he will bring the same compassionate judgement upon you. He will not only heal, resolve and restore, he will also open new windows to who he wants you to be in the Kingdom life.

When we pray for the judgement of Christ, he comes. He not only comes with complete forgiveness but he also comes with merciful resolutions – not for what you think you need but for what you really need. The end result is a full heart that sees more than it did before and causes you to exclaim with the psalmist:

This is the Lord's doing; it is marvellous in our eyes!

The Diocese of Victoria is offering free of charge, a nine-session Pastoral Care Outreach Training series (via Zoom) from April 17 to June 12th, over 9 consecutive Saturdays (9:30 to Noon). Over the past several years, as an initiative of the Diocesan Health Care Committee, training sessions for Pastoral Care Ministry volunteers to visit the lonely, sick injured, elderly, and dying - in hospitals, seniors residence extended health care facilities and homebound, were offered in-person through the Diocese. As we look to the future, the need to provide basic virtual training in order to equip more Lay Pastoral Care visitors to become part of a parish pastoral care team is essential.

This training is also offered to parishioners who care for their family members, as a means to help share the message of Christ's healing love and compassion with those in need.


