Kingdom Shrewdness

This Gospel passage is confusing and disturbing, especially if you think that the rich man, who commended his manager for his shrewdness, is representative of God. The rich man does not represent God. He is a representation of a social and political strata where money, status and power are key priorities (like the Roman Empire) and the manager represents those who hitch their wagons to those in power. The tax collectors, the hated Jewish men who served the Romans by collecting taxes from the Jewish people, would be good illustrations of that kind of hitching one's wagon to the powerful.

The manager in this parable did something intriguing: he switched sides. He didn't do so for great reasons but he switched from attending to his master's power and wealth interests to attending to the interests of the poor and his rich master admired his ingenuity in making friends with them. Jesus was saying that the children of light could use a bit of this ingenuity. He was talking directly to his disciples, who were having a hard time grasping where Jesus's heart was. They argued amongst themselves about their status and some of his followers believed Jesus would eventually overthrow the Romans and become King over all.

Jesus never sucked up to wealthy Jews, who most likely attained wealthy status by staying on the good side of the Romans, and he had no interest in trying to get the Romans to like him. Jesus had no interest in wealth at all, even when it might seem to the disciples that a bit of money could further his

mission and help him to reach more people or at least provide him with the means to overthrow a government.

Instead, Jesus made friends with the poor and oppressed, people who had no power to help him in any way, people who could never give him anything except love. These people had no opportunity to be corrupted by the promises of wealth and power, so they could be trusted with the true riches of the Kingdom.

Worldly values or God values? We need to choose.
