#### A few words from our Pastor:-

Thank you to all who have already given to the appeal.

I would like to give an update on the process of selecting the lights for the church and the costs that will be associated with them. I did not want to give a figure when we announced the project because I did not want to count eggs as chickens. Not only are we still calculating the cost of the lights, we are still reflecting on the style. This is because the Pastoral Council, the Finance Committee, the Maintenance committee, and I are also preparing replace the carpets and to repaint the church in conjunction with restoring a proper venue for the Sacrament of Reconciliation. The lights then will have to match the colour schemes of our interior, the simple elegance of the church's structure, and the need to ventilate our space. St Joseph, pray for us.

Because of all these variables, I am a little uneasy to give you a quote. But with installation and materials for the lighting portion of the project, it looks like we will be spending roughly 10 to 15 thousand dollars. This means that even if we make our immediate appeal goal for the lights, there is much more on the horizon.






