

#### THIS WEEK IN THE PARISH

#### **Reflection for the week**

#### Ruach HaKodesh

In Hebrew terms, John saw the Ruach HaKodesh descend upon Jesus and John proclaimed Jesus the Messiah. The Ruach HaKodesh is the Spirit of God who opens our eyes to see what we cannot see on our own, who shows us the reality of God which is above and beyond and around the corner from what we think we can see. It was the Ruach HaKodesh who descended on Jesus, anointed him and sent him.

Jesus was the first to be anointed but not the last. "For those God foreknew he also predestined to be conformed to the image of his Son, that he might be the firstborn among many brothers and sisters." (Romans 8:29) He was baptized, confirmed, opened new doors, tore down ancient walls and became the first of all of us. The Ruach HaKodesh, who dwelled within Jesus, gave him direct communion with the Father and was a constant and true companion to him during his time on earth, inspiring and empowering his words and actions, is available to all of us.

Jesus and the Spirit did not ever mean for either of them to become distant members of the Trinity, somewhere 'out there', watching us stumble, fail and fall. Jesus meant for us to become an integral part of the Trinity with access to all the Spiritual anointing he had and that's why he sent us the same, the very same Ruach Hakodesh to be our constant companion who conforms us to the image of God's Son and keeps us in close communion with the Trinity.

Do you feel unworthy of that concept of who you are? Just remember: God does nothing small or inconsequential. We are the ones who think of ourselves as small and inconsequential, not God. God's heart is so full of love for each of us that this love pours out in a gushing, torrential Ruach Hakodesh river. And, meanwhile, we build dams.
