

"I can see clearly now, the rain is gone. I can see all the obstacles in my way."

If only that was always true in our spiritual lives!

In this story of the healed blind man and the Pharisees who insisted that it couldn't be a miracle from God since Jesus performed it on the Sabbath, the only people in the story who displayed true sight were Jesus and the healed blind man. Even the disciples were under the darkness of the 'common knowledge' that somebody had to have sinned in order for the man to be born blind. Real blindness is the ignorance of the true nature of God and the belief that we have all the right definitions of God. We have him all packaged and labeled and anything that doesn't 'fit' is to be totally dismissed.

The healed blind man didn't give a hoot for the Pharisees' knowledge, definitions, laws, interpretations and set in stone boundaries. All he knew was that he had been blind and now he could see, and someone who was able to do that for him had to be a prophet from God. He didn't have to study the law and know all the sections and subsections of it in order to see that he was loved, healed and completely acceptable. That's true sight. It is insight. It is far sight. It is having a precise line of sight. In spite of being harassed by the Jewish authorities, when this man encountered Jesus once again, he fell down and worshipped him. His clarified inner sight prompted this gesture of absolute commitment to Jesus. The religious leadership's law bound perspective did not clear the path for the man to get to God. Jesus did.

God was in plain sight but the Pharisees were blind to his presence. Are we?


