

THIS WEEK IN THE PARISH

A few words from our Pastor:-

Last week I mentioned that I would like to publish some simple tools for growing as disciples in the world. This week, I would like to draw your attention to the central rule of prayer: consistency.

Personal prayer is an expression of our relationship with God. As with all relationships, we can suffer from the "We should get coffee sometime" problem. The same applies to Marriage. Couples need to arrange regular times together lest life tear them apart. We ought to find times in the day that are consecrated to the Lord. Even if those times are for only two or three minutes, they are a priority.

There happen to be two apps that could provide you with prayers, scripture readings and devotions to aid in your constancy in prayer: Laudate and Ibreviary. They have the daily Scripture readings in them as well as many other forms of prayer. Just as coffee can be a catalyst to a relationship, regular prayer is a primer for holiness.

After all, the primary job of the baptized is to grow in holiness.


