A few words from our Pastor:-

The goal for the recent Diocesan appeal was to update the lighting inside the church space. I am proud to say that we are getting closer and closer to revealing our progress. As mentioned, our hope is to add 4 LED ceiling fans and 4 chandeliers that will reduce our power usage, reduce glare, and increase air circulation inside the church. The delay in this project came with the fact that we are considering it in tandem with other projects. In addition to the lighting, the pastoral, finance, and maintenance committees are exploring renewal options for the church space. We have been exploring various types of flooring to replace our ageing floors as well as painting and other options for the walls. In the coming weeks, we will be displaying some of our developing options for your consideration. I would like to thank you for your generosity to our home and community and I would also like to thank an anonymous generous donor who gave us \$10,000 for the updating of our Peace room, which will be a part of this larger project. We are not only building up our church for ourselves and our children, but as a sacred space for generations to come.
