

Holy Relics of St Anthony will be visiting us on Wednesday, Oct 30th

9am Mass at *St Joseph the Worker* with veneration following the Mass until 11:30am.

Veneration in *Sacred Heart Parish* from 12:30pm to 4:00pm. Korean **Mass at 7:30pm** with veneration following the Mass.

St Anthony is visiting us in the form of two precious and first-class relics from the Pontifical Basilica in

Padua, Italy. The relics will be accompanied by Fr. Mario Conte, 1 of 51 OFM Conventual Franciscan Friars who minister in the Basilica where the Saint is buried. This is the Franciscan order of St. Francis of Assisi.

Prayer petitions with holy cards will be distributed by Friar Mario to allow parishioners to write their personal prayer petition to the saint. This is a worldwide tradition when venerating a relic of a saint. Fr. Mario will bring the petitions back to the Basilica in Padua and place them at the tomb of St. Anthony. The tour officially ends back at the Tomb of St. Anthony where the Friars will gather to pray for the saint's intercession upon our intentions and petitions.
