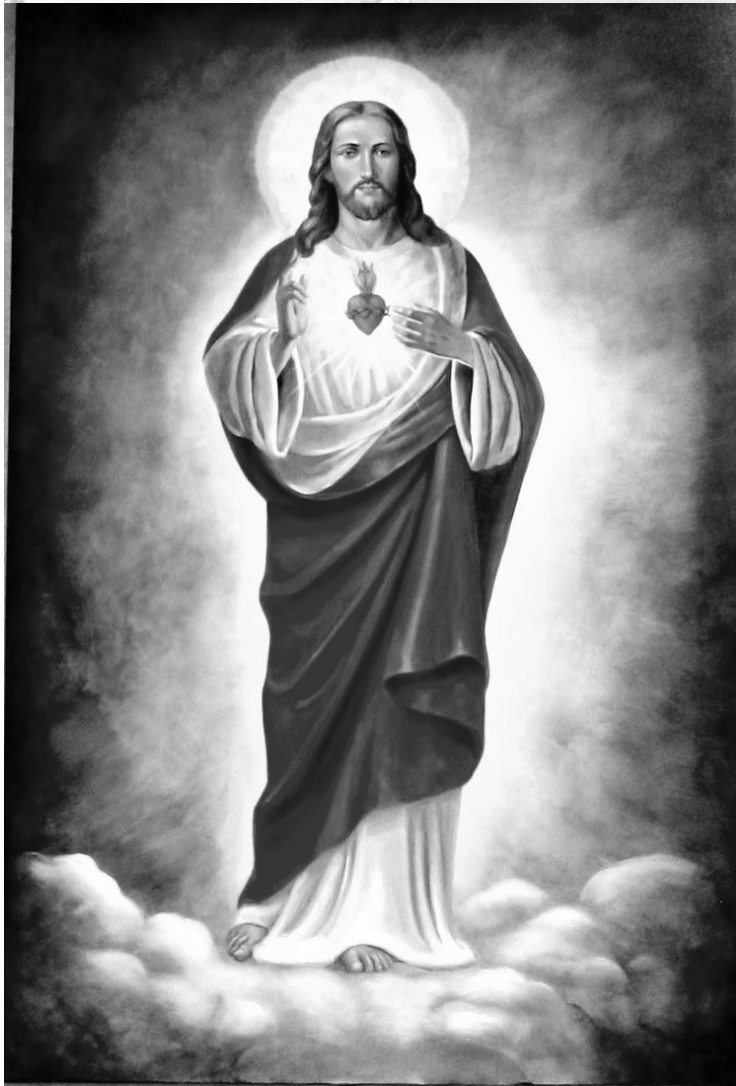

Thursday of Holy Week

Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament will be in the Parish Hall after the Mass of the Lord's Supper until midnight.

The custom of spending time with our Lord arose from the desire to have a positive response to Jesus' question in the Garden of Gethsemane, "Could you not watch one hour with me?"

Bells

Parishioners are invited to bring bells to ring during the singing of the Gloria at the Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday, Mar 24th, and Easter Vigil, Mar 26th.

Incense

Incense will be used on Holy Thursday and Easter Vigil.

Good Friday

Regulations for Fasting and Abstinence

Good Friday is a day of fasting and abstinence throughout the universal church.

Fasting is to be observed by all 18 years of age and older, who have not yet celebrated their 59th birthday. On a fast day one full meal is allowed. Two other meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to each one's needs, but together they should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted, but liquids, including milk and juices, are permitted.

Holy Land Collection

The Pontifical Collection for the benefit of the Holy Places is scheduled once a year, Good Friday.

Many Christians in the Holy Land depend on the collection for their lives. As a Pontifical collection requested by Pope Francis, the annual Good Friday Collection offers a direct link for parishioners to be witnesses of peace and to help protect the Holy Places.
