


* 3rd Sunday of Lent | March 20th, 2022 *



"If it bears fruit next year, well and good; but if not, you can cut it down."

(Luke 13.9)

My young grandson, in a burst of enthusiastic love, told his dad that "when I grow up I want to be you." We were delighted at the depth of his devotion, that his desire to *be like* his dad would expand to become the desire to *be* his dad. Perhaps that is a model for the disciples of Christ, to love Jesus so much that we desire to become Him.

The Gospel today recounts Jesus' parable of the barren fig tree. The gardener pleaded for one more year, one more chance for the fig tree to become what it was meant to become. It is a reminder of the shortness of our lives and our dependence on God's grace to create in us the fruit of holiness and good works. It is Christ within us that produces good fruit, as we become less and He becomes more.

So we seek to be transformed through our utter and complete surrender to Him, becoming more and more like Him—becoming, in a sense, Him. And just as bread and wine retain their appearance while becoming Christ, we too remain in our unique and particular form even as we are transformed.

May we bring the child-like love that my grandson expressed, as we offer ourselves in union with the offering of bread and wine on the altar.




