

We are in the second week of our appeal. As I mentioned in the Mass last week, our project for this year is to replace our hanging lights with lower energy LED lights with ceiling fans. These lights will use a significantly smaller amount of power, create less heat, and will have a lifespan measured in years. It is my hope that the electrical savings alone will be of assistance to our community.

Last year's project of expanding our bathroom capacity and developing our sacristy is still receiving some finishing touches. I believe that it can be considered a success simply in reducing washroom wait times.

We did do some electrical work in the rectory and office, but sadly, finishing the project at an appropriate price proved prohibitive.
