Gold Mass in Vancouver

A Gold Mass for scientists will be celebrated in Vancouver at St Mark's Parish at UBC on Friday, Nov 17 at 5:30pm with Archbishop Miller, CSB as main celebrant. Light refreshments will be served, all are welcome.
The Gold Mass began as an initiative of the Society of Catholic Scientists (<https://www.catholicscientists.org>) which exists to "witness to the harmony between the vocation of

scientist and the life of faith." This Mass follows in the tradition of special Masses for members of a particular profession. The patron saint of scientists is St Albert the Great – bishop, theologian and alchemist. The colour gold reflects the colour of the hoods worn by those graduating with a Ph.D. in science and because St Albert the Great was an alchemist who worked to turn base metals into gold.
