Reflection for the week

Today's readings remind us that in Christ Jesus, God has been faithful to the promises he made to his Chosen People. Our salvation in Christ is how we are reconciled back to God, who created us and loves us.

Isaiah prophesies a sign for Israel: The virgin shall conceive, and bear a son who will embody God's redemptive presence with his people. Paul, recalling his own apostolic calling writes that the Gentiles are also called to belong to Jesus Christ. In the Gospel, the Lord's angel comes to Joseph in a dream and reveals the circumstances of Mary's pregnancy, and what this means. Joseph obeys the angel's commands.

<u>Memo</u> (Dec 18, 2019) from Bishop G. Gordon and Chancellor, Cynthia Bouchard regarding **Pastoral** **Fr. Stephen Paine** has been granted a **sabbatical** for a year and thus will be relinquishing his pastorship of St. Edward's Parish in Duncan, St. Louis de Montfort Parish in Lake Cowichan, and Queen of Angels School in Duncan.
