## Son-light Versus Sunlight

The healed blind man was being harassed by the world around him. He probably felt like he was being more marginalized than he was when he was a blind beggar. There would have been many who knew what the Pharisees thought and consequently shunned the man even more than before.

Jesus had earlier proclaimed himself as the Light of the World and later found the man he healed and asked, "Do you believe in the Son of Man?" He did not rescue the man from being treated badly; he simply opened up the man's heart and eyes and gave him inner Son-light to go along with the man's new experience of natural sunlight. He gave the man the true light to focus on and believe in.

Today, we are being harassed by Covid-19 and, as Christians, we are called to respond in wisdom by seriously following the protocols laid out by our leaders. We are beleaguered but Jesus is not swooping down and miraculously rescuing us all immediately from this virus. He simply asks us all the same question, "Do you believe in the Son of Man?" He asks us to keep our attention pointed in the right direction.

We need to believe that the Light of Christ permeates the world and that He can take what seems devastating to us and use it to permeate even more of the world with His Light. We believe He can light up our hearts with better inner sight as we endeavour to focus more on Him than on what we can see with our natural eyes. Our belief can make this whole time of uncertainty part of our Lenten journey, a time given to us to draw close once again to Jesus and refocus our eyes on His.

Jesus said, "In the world you will have tribulation but be of good cheer. I have overcome the world."

## **Televised Mass**

**Salt + Light TV** has made arrangements with cable companies across Canada (Rogers, Bell, Telus, Shaw Direct, Videotron) to make **Salt + Light TV** available **free of charge** to all subscribers until May 1, 2020.
