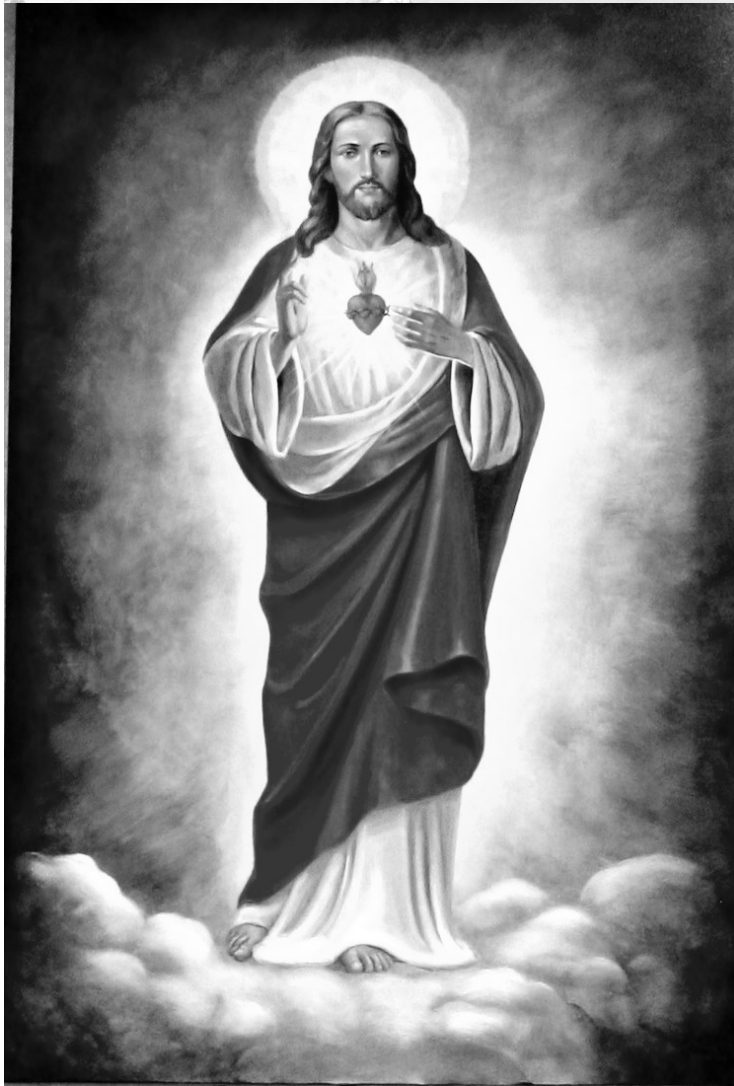

The themes of the videos have been selected from the most frequently-asked questions we receive.

The inaugural series, *End-of-Life Care*, examines "Death"; "Forgoing Treatment"; "Euthanasia and Physician-assisted Suicide"; and "The Principle of Double Effect." Videos on "Palliative Care"; "Pain Relief at the End of Life"; "Donation of Vital Organs"; and "Conscience" will be available next.
