

A few words from our Pastor

Many things compete for our attention on a daily basis. Some of the things we do, we do in light of our faith and in the service of God; other things may draw us away from both. Jesus exhorts us to pay attention to our actions and our motives, for we cannot serve both God and the things of this world.

From the prophet Amos comes a warning to the people of the Northern Kingdom of Israel: that God sees those who mistreat or take advantage of the poor and needy; that He will not forget a thing they have done. In Paul's Letter to Timothy, he asks for prayers for those in authority and that they be pleasing to the Lord. In Luke's Gospel, Jesus tells the parable of the dishonest steward, and says that a person must be trustworthy in matters big and small, for no one can serve both God and wealth.
