Glorified Jesus

“Today this Scripture has been fulfilled in your hearing.”

(Luke 4.21)

In the Gospel, Jesus returns to a familiar verse from the prophet Isaiah but does not simply quote it. He lays out the next steps for our path, fulfilling the command in our hearing. ...

On this Sunday of the Word of God, promulgated by Pope Francis in September 2019, we turn to the Word as people who can “hear with understanding.” In the First Reading, Ezra does not stand alone; and in the Second Reading, Paul reminds us the body is not one member. These are timely texts as we observe the Week of Prayer for Christian Unity. May we know the power of the Spirit as we go about this mission, together.

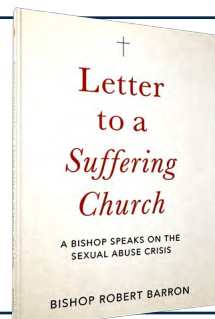

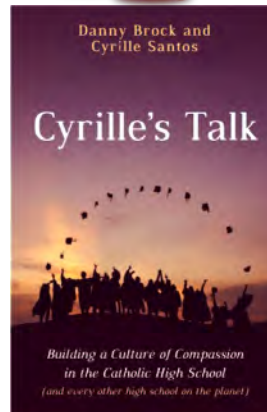
