

Relax Into Desire By Jean Allen

"Lavish, magnanimous, bountiful, ungrudging, unstinting, munificent, benevolent, prodigal, profuse, abounding, copious, generous." These are words the labourers who only worked one hour in the vineyard could have easily used to describe the landowner who paid them the same wages as those who labored all day.

"Unfair, biased, unethical, unjust, stingy, miserly, cheap, mean, underhanded, unscrupulous, fraudulent, callous, perverse, cold, pitiless." These are words the labourers who worked all day could have easily used to describe the same landowner who paid them the same wages as those who had only worked one hour.

Which set of words will we use for God when we pass from this life to the next and witness people going in before us, (who, as far as we could tell, did diddly-squat in serving God or who only acknowledged God in the last minute), and receiving the same loving and joyful welcome as us? This question can either cause us to recognize our underlying need for God (and others) to exclusively recognize our righteous labour for him and can highlight an underlying resentment towards those who aren't as labour intensive as we are – or it can bring us enormous hope.

God doesn't judge according to quantity or even quality, which is pretty good news for most of us! He simply recognizes and welcomes the willing and desirous heart. He doesn't practice generosity according to our standards of what is 'enough'. The Kingdom is not based on the 'reward for goods received' system like the world does. It is actually quite difficult for us to get our heads around that and hard for us to understand unconditional generous love. Perhaps we will never quite get it until we pass over to our Kingdom home.

But, meanwhile, it would be good to reflect on how many words in the above lists apply to us. After pondering that, we might be super relieved that God does not operate on a tit for tat reward system.

And maybe we'll get a glimpse of the true meaning of unconditional love.


