

"Blessed are those who have not seen and yet have come to believe."

(John 20.29)

God's love for us is unlimited. Easter is the ultimate demonstration of that. So why do we sometimes limit what we can receive from God?

In Grade 8, my favourite sport was basketball and I was happily surprised to make the school team. I didn't enjoy the experience, though, because I felt I didn't know what I was doing and would be found out at any moment. Similarly, in today's Gospel, Thomas closed himself off to God's gifts.

When Jesus appeared to the disciples, they were afraid and uncertain. He brought them the comfort and sense of purpose they needed. Thomas was not present for this encounter, but he too was probably afraid and longed for reassurance. He had seen Jesus perform miracles and knew that Jesus was capable of rising from the dead. The disciples' words could have been enough for Thomas to receive the peace and purpose that Jesus wanted to give him. Instead, he chose to remain in fear and doubt for a whole week longer than everyone else.

Jesus didn't give up on Thomas. He came back just for him. This time, Thomas responded eagerly and open-heartedly. Let us have an eager and open faith and guard against fear and doubt so that we can enjoy the limitless gifts God has for us.

The Diocese of Victoria is grateful to Fr. Konrad Zaborowksi, SDS, who in August 2021 agreed to serve as Administrator *Pro Tempore* at Sacred Heart Parish in Victoria while waiting for his visa for work in the United States to be processed.

His devoted ministry to God's people has been a source of blessing for our Diocese. Fr. Konrad's visa has now been approved, and he will be moving to Miami to take up a teaching position at Saint John Vianney College Seminary. Fr. Konrad's last day at Sacred Heart will be Monday, May 9, 2022.

We thank Fr. Konrad for his service to our Diocese, and pray that his new position will be an opportunity for personal and spiritual growth, both for him and for his students.

PASCHA

24th April 2022 is Pascha, Easter Sunday for Ukrainian Catholics and other Christians who follow the Julian Calendar. The Canadian Council of Churches (CCC), in collaboration with the Canadian Bishops of the Ukrainian Catholic and Ukrainian Orthodox Churches, has issued an invitation to Christians in Canada to pray for peace in Ukraine and to ring church bells at noon local time today.
