Not My Will But Yours



It's very easy to take parts of this Gospel out of context and think that it means that whatever we want, if we pray persistently enough, we'll get it. There have been a lot of discouraged, frustrated and devastated souls who believed that God was supposed to give them anything they prayed for, sure that they must have prayed the wrong way or without enough persistence.

This Gospel text begins with the disciples asking Jesus to teach them to pray and Jesus gifts them with the Lord's Prayer. The disciples did not ask Jesus to show them how to pray for miracles, just how to pray. After his discourse about being persistent and believing God had good things to give them he said, "If you then, who are evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will the heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to those who ask him?" The Holy Spirit. Not "anything you think you want".

The truth is that we need the Holy Spirit to help us pray with wisdom. We need his wisdom because we always think we know what we or other people need and our prayers are usually based on personal biases and limited foresight. We think God must want what we want. If he doesn't want what we want then maybe if we're persistent enough he'll get with the program.

Look at the Lord's prayer. It establishes the Father as the one who knows what is needed. It proclaims the perfect will of God. It brings us before him in humility and simply asks for daily bread, which covers all our needs. Then it goes into the absolute prerequisite for prayer wisdom: "Forgive us our sins, for we ourselves forgive everyone indebted to us." Not just some people. Everyone. Not much wiggle room here.

Pray for the Holy Spirit. Pray for the grace to forgive. Pray for wisdom. Persist in these prayers. Don't give up!

These are prayers God always answers.


