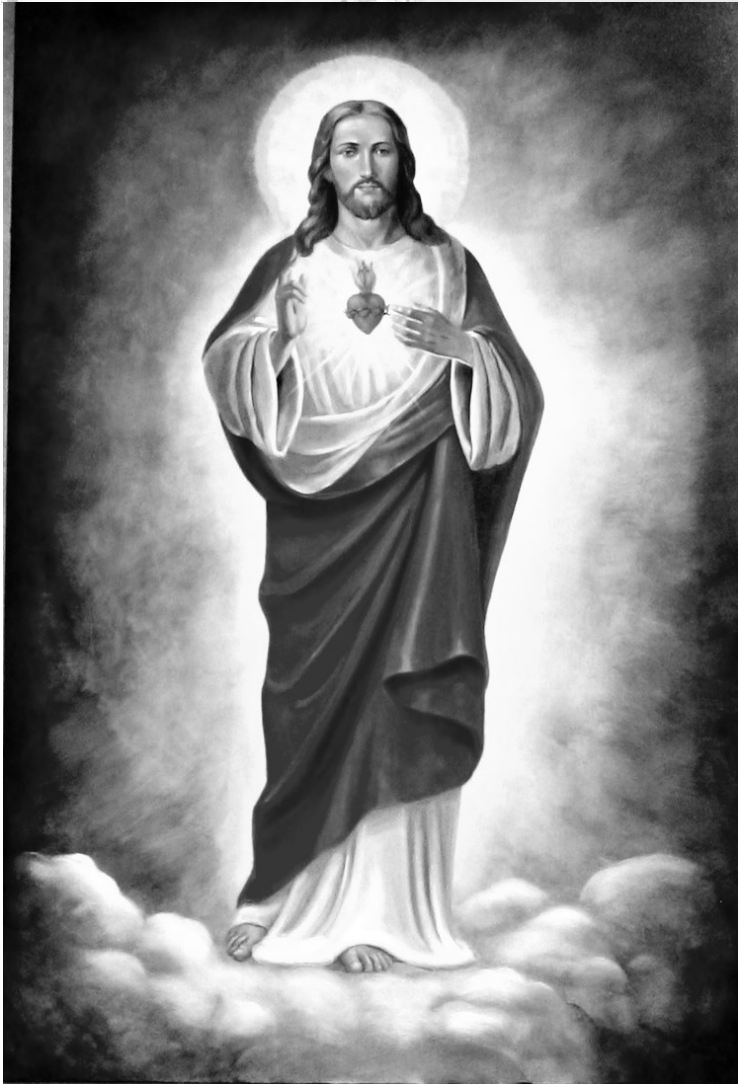

Chrism Mass

On Thursday, March 22nd at 7:00pm, at the Cathedral, Bishop Gary Gordon will be the principal celebrant at a Mass that is celebrated annually.

At this liturgy, we gather around the bishop for the blessing and consecration of the oils that will be used in all our parishes in the coming year.

May our presence at the Chrism Mass be a sign of our support and gratitude for their ministry—and a reminder that baptism calls all of us to lives of service.
All are invited to attend. A reception will follow.
