

You know what? We are truly a blessed people and very dear to God's heart. When Jesus raised Lazarus from the dead, he did so in order that the crowd of Jews watching him would see that he was from God and believe in him. How many dead people have you seen raised to life? Yet, I'm pretty sure every one of you reading this reflection believe that Jesus is from God and have committed your lives to him. "Blessed are those who have not seen and yet have believed."

Something that caught my eye in this reading was that it says, "Many of the Jews therefore, who had come with Mary and had seen what Jesus did, believed in him." Many. Not all. There were actually people there who saw Lazarus come out of the tomb after being

dead for four days and they still did not believe in Jesus. It reminds me of a scene in 'The Last Battle', a book in the Narnia series by C.S. Lewis, where a group of disgruntled dwarves had decided nobody was going to fool them. "Dwarves are for the dwarves!" They refused to believe they were in Aslan's country (heaven) with a wonderful feast laid before them. All they could perceive were a filthy stable, rotten vegetables, hay, thistles and dirty water. In the end, Aslan (Christ) could do nothing for them because of their stubborn unbelief. He did not punish them; they were already in enough misery in their self-created 'reality'.

But you believe. You believe in spite of prayers that seem to go unanswered. You believe right in the midst of difficult and messy circumstances that often smell like death. You hurt but you believe. You slip and fall and it feels as if no one is there to catch you and you believe. You often feel abandoned and still you believe. You have no idea how cherished you are by the Holy Trinity and all the company of heaven because, in spite of it all, you believe.


