If the Readings today were scenes in a movie, it would be quite dramatic. Keeping up with the characters and the content would be challenging.

The First Reading shows Elijah calling Elisha, where Elisha seems unsure of what to do. Elijah allows him to finish what he is doing first. Paul, in the Second Reading, is outlining the perpetual tension Christians carry being in this world but not of this world.

The Gospel is where it all comes together. Jesus has His face set toward Jerusalem, knowing this is where His ministry will end with suffering and death. We are introduced to the would-be followers. On the surface, what they say seems to sound like excuses. Yet we know these are valid concerns—responsibility and care for family, burying the dead, helping with the family business—these things matter. Jesus’ response is designed to help them (and us) discern their commitment.

Discipleship is no small matter and will demand much from us.

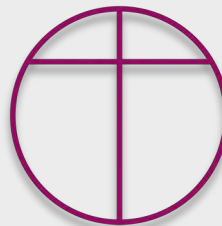
### Starting October 6 , 2022 Learn more about your Faith at Saint Joseph the Worker Parish

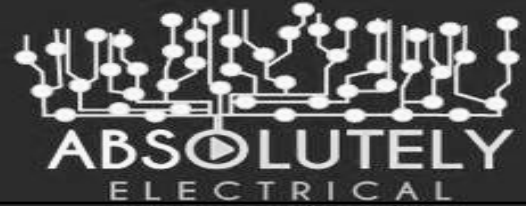
