"No good tree bears bad fruit, nor again does a bad tree bear good fruit;..."

(Luke 6.43)

"Please engage brain before starting mouth."

The simple fact is that too often our unthinking words betray the real us. In the first reading, the Jewish scribe Sirach, who compiled his ethical teachings about 200 years before the birth of Jesus, faces this fault. He knows our words do disclose the "cultivation of the mind."

Words and deeds combine to reflect our true selves. We are called as followers of Jesus to listen to Him. He offers us the way to reshape our lives so that our actions bear good fruit. Successfully removing the log from our eye, which Luke speaks of, suggests a first step. This will promote the "steadfast love" the psalmist speaks of, causing us to flourish into old age. Paul similarly exhorts the Corinthians and us to continue to "be steadfast, immovable, always excelling in the work of the Lord." If we are faithful in word and deed, then our struggles to lead a good life will not be in vain. Death will have no sting.

We must learn from our teacher. Now what about that log in our eye?




