

A few words from our Pastor:-

Some have been asking me about any upcoming adult faith formation classes in our Parish. I have been hinting that I wanted to do a series of talks during Lent on suffering, the problem of evil, and the importance of Christian Hope.

After some reflection, I am happy to announce that starting on the first Friday of Lent, I will be offering a series of sermons on the Stations of the Cross after our own Stations devotions at 6pm. Rather than being a series of lectures that are simply meant to form the mind, these talks are meant to enlighten and encourage the disciple as they walk the path of the Lord's Cross. Also, these talks will not be lectures, but a mini-in-Parish mission. The talks will be about 20 minutes in length and will cover the meaning of each station over the course of the few weeks. 
